





Pamela Kay

Life and Career

A graduate of the Royal College of Art's Textile School and Canterbury College of Art, where she earned a Fine Art degree.

Pamela initially pursued a career as a freelance textile designer. Her designs, acclaimed for their elegance and innovation, were produced by renowned companies such as Tibor Reich, David Whitehead, Liberty's, and John Lewis. Despite being appointed as Head of the Design Production Department at John Lewis, Pamela chose to return to her true passion - painting.

Her dedication to her craft led to her election as an Associate of the Royal Society of Painters in Watercolour (ARWS) in 1983, and shortly thereafter, she became a full member of both the Royal Society of British Artists (RBA) and the Royal Society of Painters in Watercolours (RWS) in 1985. Additionally, Pamela joined the prestigious New English Art Club (NEAC) that same year.

Pamela's artistic journey has taken her across the globe, where she has painted stunning landscapes and scenes during cruises on Swan Hellenic's ships, including the Orpheus, Minerva, and Minerva II. Her travels have spanned Hong Kong, Vietnam, Thailand, India, Sri Lanka, the Yemen, the Middle East, the Mediterranean, and the Baltic countries, all of which have influenced her vibrant works.

Pamela's contributions to the art world are also captured in publications such as "The Art of Pamela Kay" by Michael Spender and her own book, "Gouache - A Personal View," which explores a range of subjects from still life to watercolours of her travels.

Additionally, her technique and process are showcased in the APV Filmsproduced DVD "Aspects of Flower Painting in Oils," offering a glimpse into Pamela's creative process.

Pamela has exhibited her work in numerous prestigious venues, including a solo exhibition as Festival Artist at The Beaney in Canterbury. She has also shown her work consistently at the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition, further solidifying her reputation as a distinguished artist.
